ID'S COMMUNITY IMPACT 2025-2026

MAKING SPORT ACCESSIBLE: OUR COMMUNITY IMPACT

Over the past year, ID in the Community has continued to remove barriers to sport and physical activity, creating opportunities for children and families across our local communities.

Through our ID Compete programme, we delivered free football, dodgeball and foursquare events, providing approximately 218 participation opportunities across 18 school attendances. These events gave children the chance to compete, develop confidence and build friendships in a supportive environment. Our girls' football tournament was a particular highlight, with around 30% of participants experiencing competitive football for the first time.

We also continued to bring innovation to school sport through our ID Compete Virtual Challenges. Using online leaderboards and digital certificates, schools and holiday camps could compete from different locations. In total, 655 challenge attempts and scores were recorded, encouraging children to stay active while making competition more accessible.

Our ID Reboot sports kit recycling initiative has helped families access quality equipment at affordable prices while reducing waste. A recent pop-up shop at Brookfield School raised £230, which will be reinvested into future community initiatives.

Holiday provision has also remained central to our work. Through the Hampshire Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) Programme, we provided 707 booked places across four venues, helping children stay active, eat well, make friends and enjoy positive experiences during the school holidays.

Finally, our partnership with Sarisbury Athletic Cricket Club raised a record £9,503 through the 24-Hour Charity Cycle, funding 14 days of junior cricket holiday camps and new coaching equipment.

Together, we are helping more children get active, build confidence and feel connected to their communities.
