This pack contains:

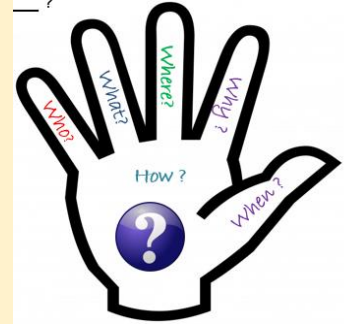
- 1 history activity, 1 art activity, 1 science activity.

How do you think they were used?



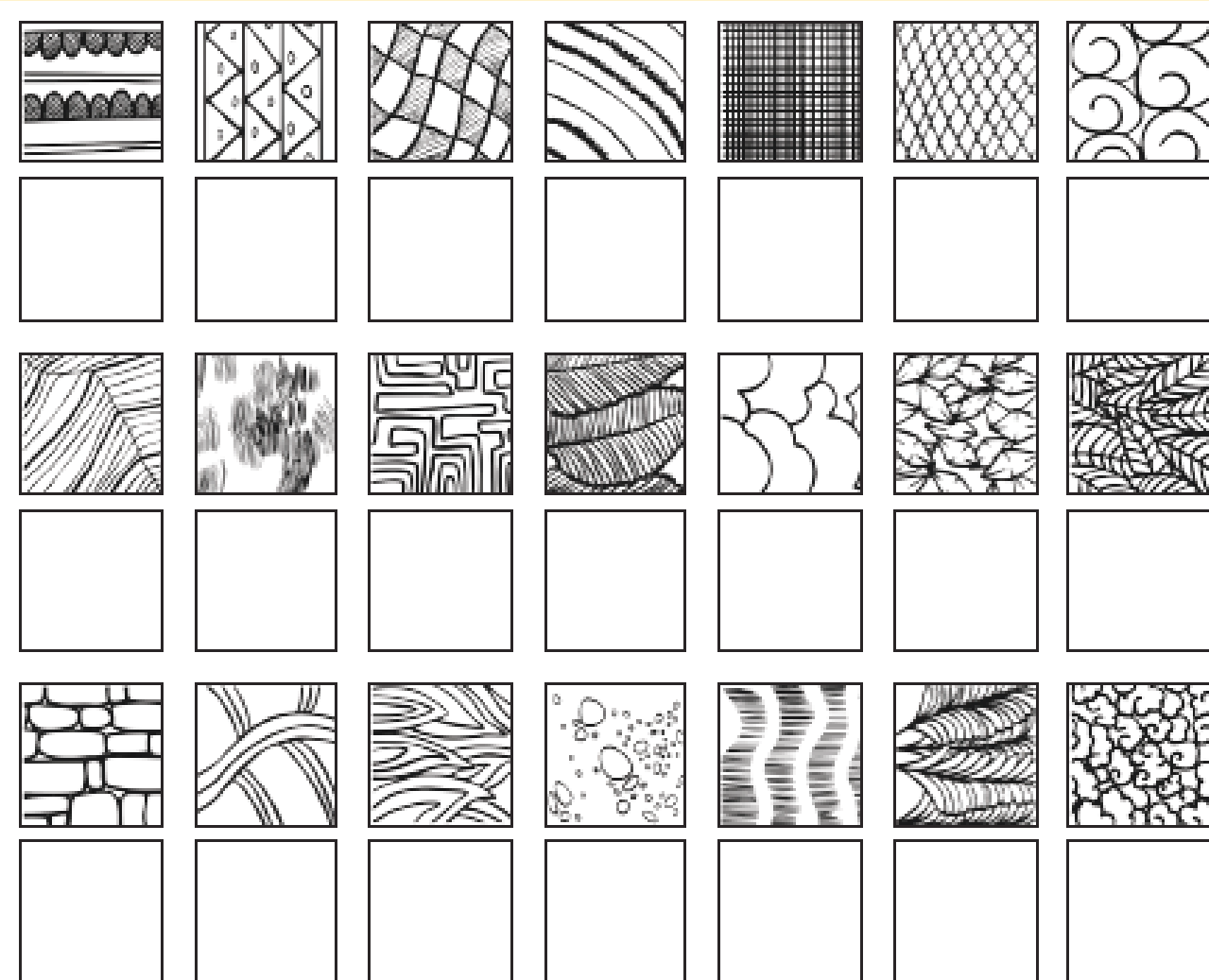
What questions do you have about the artefacts and places?

LO: To make a variety of marks and patterns.

Science - Rocks and soils

Key idea : There are different types of rocks.
