# <u>Science - Spring Watch</u> Can I make observations of how an environment changes over time?

Our new topic for the next half term is spring watch. Over the next six weeks, you are going to choose a few patches outside that you can look at and see how they change every week. This could be somewhere you walk, your garden or just outside where you live. You do not need to go anywhere special.

Your task - Create a diary about what you see! If you can, take a photo of each patch or area that you look at. If you cant, draw and make notes about what you see. Have a look on the next page to see the areas we have chosen to look at in school.

You could make a rain fall gauge and calculate how much rain falls each week. You can have a go at making a rain gauge using this <u>video</u>. Measure the amount of water each week and write it in your diary.

### Religious Education - Who is Buddha?


Read through the power point called 'The Buddha' on the school website.

The Buddha was born Siddhartha Gautama in a town called Lumbini, in India, near Nepal about 2500 years ago	Before his birth, his Mother Queen Maya had a dream a special dream that meant the child was going to be important.	The King did not want his son to see suffering. Siddartha lived a life of luxury sheltered from the realities of the world. He married a beautiful princess, Yasodhara.	The King attempted to protect Siddartha from the world but he was not happy living like a prisoner. One day he went out hunting and he saw four sights: Old age, Sickness, Death and a holy man (Poverty).
Each of the four sights made Siddartha sad and this made him think about life. The day after his son Rahula was born; Siddartha decided that he must leave home in a quest for enlightenment.	He spent six years travelling around India. He then lived as a Holy man with no money, clothes or luxury. He near to death when he realised this was not the answer. He decided a middle way was better between extreme luxury and extreme poverty	Siddhartha sat himself under a Bodhi tree and meditated. He was faced with many temptations sent by Mara - the force of evil. Then gradually as morning came he saw things in a new way, he became enlightened and the supreme Buddha.	He decided to share his teachings and ideas. In Buddhism, there is one person whose life and teaching helps people to understand more about life. Buddhists believe he was the wisest teacher of all. His name was Siddharta Gautama but he is known by his special title; the Buddha.


The main aim of the campaign is to get and keep people moving whilst trying to have some fun!

### Art - Paper weaving






