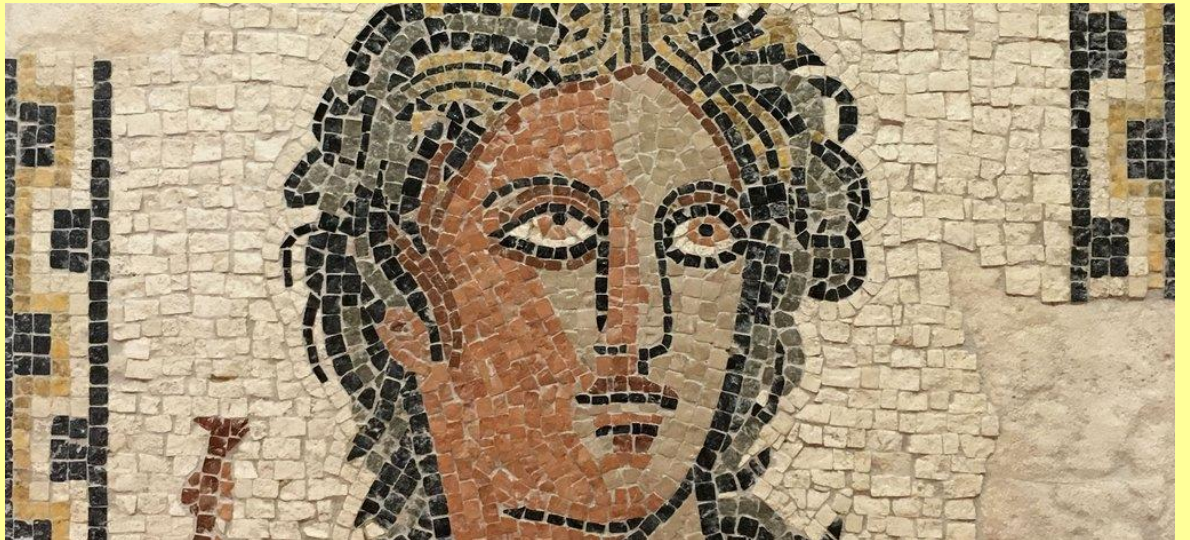

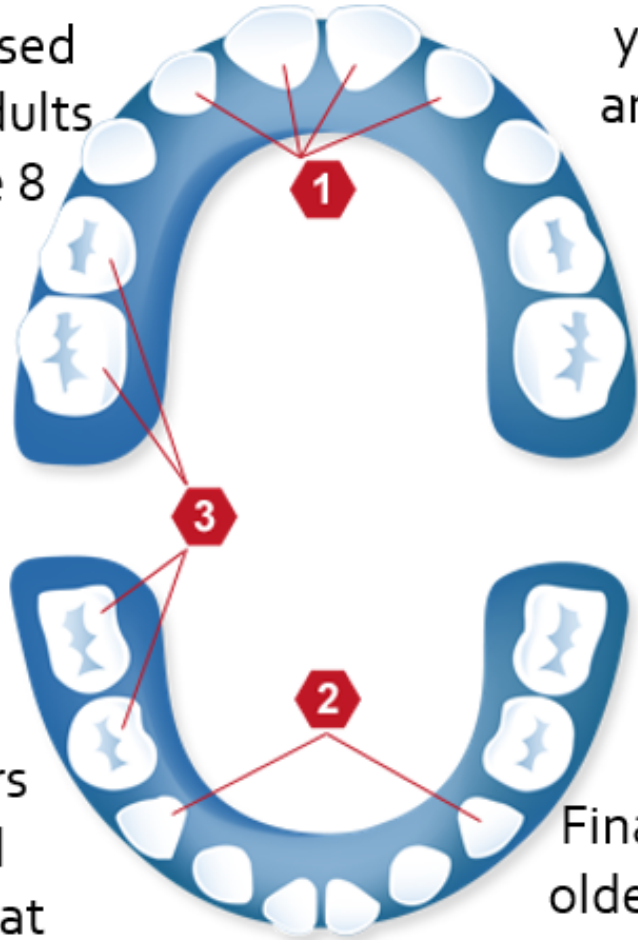
- Mosaics were very popular within the Roman times. They were used to show wealth and importance.
- Can you find some examples of some Roman mosaics and create a set of instructions on how to complete them?

Science -

The front 4 at the top and bottom are your incisors. These are used to bite your food. Adults and children all have 8 incisors altogether.

This is where it changes... Children have 2 molars, but adults have 2 premolars, 2 molars. Molars and pre molars are used to mash and crush your food so that you can swallow it easily.



The 2 pointed teeth at the top and bottom are your canines. These rip and tear your food, and are often used when you're eating meat. Adults and children have the same number of canines.

Finally, when people are older, they grow wisdom teeth, which are right at the back of their mouth.
